

Interim order reviews

An <u>interim order</u> will usually be reviewed every six months. This can happen either at a hearing or a meeting. We will invite the nurse, midwife or nursing associate to attend the review hearing, or to send in representations if the order is being reviewed at a meeting.

Review meetings are held in private and the panel will be invited to confirm the interim order currently in place.
