Decision on Undertakings

You currently have a health condition that it is capable of impairing your fitness to practise.

This conduct does not meet with the standards expected of nurses, midwives and nursing associates. The Code sets out the relevant standards of conduct at paragraphs 20.9.

20.9 maintain the level of health you need to carry out your professional role.

We hope these undertakings provide you with a safe and supportive pathway back to unrestricted practice.

The registrant has agreed to the following undertakings

Undertaking	Detail	Time to Complete
Undertaking1	You will limit your nursing practice to one substantive employer. You must not work as an agency nurse.	12 months from effective start date
Undertaking2	You will ensure that you are supervised whilst working at all times on the same shift as, but not always directly observed by a suitably qualified nurse, midwife, mentor, workplace supervisor or manager.	12 months from effective start date
Undertaking3	You will not dispense or administer any medications, including vaccinations, unless directly supervised by a workplace supervisor or mentor who is a registered nurse or doctor. This supervision will consist of: Being observed preparing and administering medications and the associated record keeping until you have been assessed and deemed competent to administer and record medication unsupervised by your workplace supervisor or mentor. To be deemed competent you must have undertaken and successfully completed at least three supervised medication competency assessments. Each assessment must take place on a different shift. You will send your case officer the medication administration	12 months from effective start date

	competencies within one month of all three assessments being completed. The expectation is that you will have been deemed competent within 12 months of these undertakings becoming effective.	
Undertaking4	You will keep us informed about anywhere you are working by: a. Telling your case officer within seven days of accepting or leaving any employment. b. Giving your case officer your employer's contact details.	12 months from effective start date
Undertaking5	You will keep us informed about anywhere you are studying by: a. Telling your case officer within seven days of accepting any course of study. b. Giving your case officer the name and contact details of the organisation offering that course of study.	12 months from effective start date
Undertaking6	You will immediately give a copy of these undertakings to: a. Any organisation or person you work for b. Any employers you apply to for work (at the time of application). c. Any establishment you apply to (at the time of application), or with which you are already enrolled, for a course of study	12 months from effective start date
Undertaking7	You will tell your case officer, within seven days of your becoming aware of: • Any clinical incident you are involved in. • Any investigation started against you. • Any disciplinary proceedings taken against you.	12 months from effective start date
Undertaking8	You will allow your case officer to share, as necessary, details about your performance, your compliance with and progress towards completing these undertakings with: • Any current or future employer. • Any educational establishment. • Any other person(s) involved in your retraining and/or supervision required by these undertakings.	12 months from effective start date
