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Decision on Warning

In 2022 you displayed inappropriate behaviour and use of social media and failed to safeguard a patient in your care. This conduct does not meet with the standards expected of nurses, midwives and nursing associates and could undermine public confidence in the nursing and midwifery professions. The Code (NMC 2015, updated 2018) sets out the relevant standards of practice and behaviour at paragraphs 1, 1.1, 17, 17.1, 20, 20.1 and 20.3.

1 Treat people as individuals and uphold their dignity

To achieve this, you must:

1.1 treat people with kindness, respect and compassion

17 Raise concerns immediately if you believe a person is vulnerable or at risk and needs extra support and protection

To achieve this, you must:

17.1 take all reasonable steps to protect people who are vulnerable or at risk from harm, neglect or abuse

20 Uphold the reputation of your profession at all times

To achieve this, you must:

20.1 keep to and uphold the standards and values set out in the Code

20.3 be aware at all times of how your behaviour can affect and influence the behaviour of other people

You have shown insight into your conduct and addressed any risks.
