

The NMC Register Northern Ireland Mid-year update

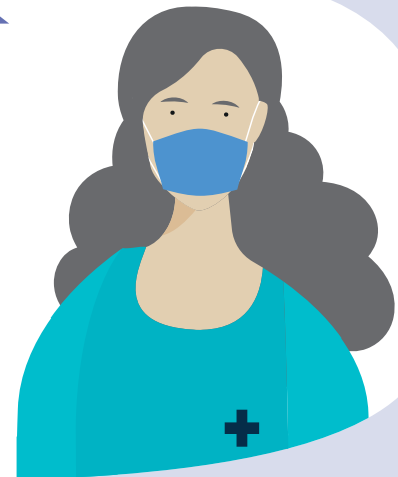
1 April–30 September 2021



The number of nurses and midwives on our register in Northern Ireland grew from 26,151 at the beginning of April to 26,229 at the end of September.

In comparison, the number of professionals in Northern Ireland grew by 469 (1.8%) during the same period the previous year, April to September 2020.

The number of nurses on our register in Northern Ireland grew from 24,596 in April to 24,690 in September.

From April to September 2020, the number of nurses grew by 449 (1.9%).

The number of midwives on our register in Northern Ireland decreased from 1,247 in April to 1,221 in September.

From April to September 2020, the number of midwives increased by four (0.3%).

The number of dual registrants (people registered as both a nurse and midwife) in Northern Ireland increased from 308 in April to 318 in September.

From April to September 2020, the number of dual registrants increased by 16 (5.4%).
