Decision and reasons on application for hearing to be held in private

At the outset of the hearing, Ms Bass made a request that the entirety of the hearing be held in private on the basis that proper exploration of Miss Gallagher's case relates to her health. She submitted that the conduct matters in the case are inexplicably linked to Miss Gallagher's health. The application was made pursuant to Rule 19 of 'Nursing and Midwifery Council (Fitness to Practise) Rules 2004', as amended (the Rules).

The legal assessor reminded the panel that while Rule 19(1) provides, as a starting point, that hearings shall be conducted in public, Rule 19(3) states that the panel may hold hearings partly or wholly in private if it is satisfied that this is justified by the interests of any party or by the public interest.

Having heard that the case relates to Miss Gallagher's health condition, the panel determined to hold the entirety of the hearing in private.
