The suspension order will be reviewed every six months. This order will run for the remainder of the 18 months.

At that review and any following review, a panel may revoke the order, it may confirm the suspension order, or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order. In certain circumstances, it may be possible for the interim order to be reviewed by a panel at an administrative meeting. Mrs Shaw's case officer will write to her about this in due course.

Mrs Shaw should notify the NMC immediately of any material change of circumstances that may affect the interim order.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Mrs Shaw. The NMC will write to Mrs Shaw when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

This decision will be confirmed to Mrs Shaw in writing.
