Application under Rule 19

Ms Mohamed made an application for the entire of Mr Allan's case to be heard in private on the basis that the matters which the panel had to consider were inextricably linked with Mr Allan's health. The application was made pursuant to Rule 19 of The Nursing and Midwifery Council (Fitness to Practise) Rules 2004 (as amended) (the Rules).

The legal assessor reminded the panel that while Rule 19(1) provides, as a starting point, that hearings shall be conducted in public, Rule 19(3) states that the panel may hold hearings partly or wholly in private if it is satisfied that this is justified by the interests of any party or by the public interest.

Having read the papers, the panel was aware that Mr Allan's health is inextricably linked with this case. It was satisfied that Mr Allan's right to privacy and confidentiality in respect of his health outweighed the interest in holding the hearing in public. It therefore determined to hold the entire hearing in private.
