Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to make an interim suspension order for a period of 18 months.

You will be invited to attend this hearing in person, send a representative on your behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider.

At that review hearing the reviewing panel may revoke the interim order, it may confirm the interim suspension order or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order.

A panel of the Investigating Committee has still to deal with the allegations made against you. The NMC will keep you informed of developments in relation to that issue.
