## **Decision and reasons on interim order**

The panel decided to make an interim suspension order for a period of 18 months.

Unless Mr Rios Vigil's case has already been concluded, this interim order must be reviewed before the end of the next six months and every six months thereafter.

Additionally, Mr Rios Vigil or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed if any new evidence becomes available that may be relevant to the interim order.

At any review the reviewing panel may revoke the interim order, may confirm the interim order or it may replace the interim suspension order with an interim conditions of practice order.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Mr Rios Vigil. The NMC will write to Mr Rios Vigil when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

This will be confirmed to Mr Rios Vigil in writing.
