## Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

The panel has determined that the following conditions are proportionate and appropriate:

For the purposes of these conditions, 'employment' and 'work' mean any paid or unpaid post in a nursing, midwifery or nursing associate role. Also, 'course of study' and 'course' mean any course of educational study connected to nursing, midwifery or nursing associates.

- You must limit your nursing practice to Chelsea and Westminster Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.
- 2. You must not administer medication or be the second checker, unless you are directly observed by a registered nurse.
- 3. You must attend meetings with a registered nurse who is your line manager, mentor or supervisor at least monthly to discuss your:
  - a) Clinical performance
  - b) Record keeping
  - c) Administration of medication and checking of medication
- 4. Before any review hearing or meeting, you must send your case officer a report from your line manager, mentor, or supervisor commenting on your:
  - a) Clinical performance
  - b) Record keeping
  - c) Administration of medication and checking of medication
- 5. You must keep us informed about anywhere you are studying by:
  - Telling your case officer within seven days of accepting any course of study.
  - b) Giving your case officer the name and contact details of the organisation offering that course of study.

- 6. You must immediately give a copy of these conditions to:
  - a) Chelsea and Westminster Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust.
  - b) Any establishment you apply to (at the time of application), or with which you are already enrolled, for a course of study.
- 7. You must tell your case officer, within seven days of your becoming aware of:
  - a) Any clinical incident you are involved in.
  - b) Any investigation started against you.
  - c) Any disciplinary proceedings taken against you.

Unless Ms Bonyad's case has already been concluded, this interim order must be reviewed before the end of the next six months and every six months thereafter.

Additionally, Ms Bonyad or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed if any new evidence becomes available that may be relevant to the interim order.

At any review a panel may revoke the interim order or any condition of it, it may confirm the interim order, or vary any condition of it, or it may replace the interim conditions of practice order with an interim suspension order.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Ms Bonyad. The NMC will write to Ms Bonyad when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

This will be confirmed to Ms Bonyad in writing.

That concludes this determination.
