- You must restrict your nursing practice to one substantive employer, namely South Eastern Health and Social Care Trust.

- 3. You must ensure that you are directly supervised by another registered nurse any time you are managing or administering medication.

- a. Telling your case officer within seven days of accepting any course of study.
- b. Giving your case officer the name and contact details of the organisation offering that course of study.
- 13. You must immediately give a copy of these conditions to:
 - a. South Eastern Health and Social Care Trust
 - b. Any establishment you apply to (at the time of application), or with which you are already enrolled, for a course of study.
- 14. You must tell your case officer, within seven days of your becoming aware of:
 - a. Any clinical incident you are involved in.
 - b. Any investigation started against you.
 - c. Any disciplinary proceedings taken against you.
- 15. You must allow your case officer to share, as necessary, details about your performance, your compliance with and / or progress under these conditions with:
 - a. South Eastern Health and Social Care Trust
 - b. Any educational establishment.
 - c. Any other person(s) involved in your retraining and/or supervision required by these conditions.
