Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions practice order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim conditions of practice order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Mrs Ramshaw will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Mrs Ramshaw is entitled to have the interim conditions of practice order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Mrs Ramshaw will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Mrs Ramshaw must inform her case officer if she would like the interim conditions of practice order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Mrs Ramshaw does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Mrs Ramshaw and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Mrs Ramshaw in writing.
