## Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless Mr Tan's case has already been concluded, this interim order must be reviewed before the end of the next six months and every six months thereafter. Additionally, Mr Tan or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed if any new evidence becomes available that may be relevant to the interim order.

At any review, the reviewing panel may revoke the interim order or may replace the interim suspension order with an interim conditions of practice order.

In certain circumstances, it may be possible for the interim suspension order to be reviewed by a reviewing panel at an administrative meeting. Mr Tan's case officer will write to him about this in due course.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Mr Tan. The NMC will write to Mr Tan when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

This will be confirmed to Mr Tan in writing.
