## Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

The panel has determined that the following conditions are proportionate and appropriate:

- 1. You must limit your work to one substantive employer, the identity of which must be promptly notified to the NMC.
- 2. You must not access patient records in the course of your work as a nurse or otherwise unless it is required for your clinical work.

Unless Mrs Dunglison's case has already been concluded, this interim order must be reviewed before the end of the next six months and every six months thereafter. Additionally, Mrs Dunglison or the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) may ask for the interim order to be reviewed if any new evidence becomes available that may be relevant to the interim order.

At any review a panel may revoke the interim order or any condition of it, it may confirm the interim order, or vary any condition of it, or it may replace the interim conditions of practice order with an interim suspension order.

A panel of the Fitness to Practise Committee has still to deal with the allegations made against Mrs Dunglison. The NMC will keep Mrs Dunglison informed of developments in relation to that issue.

This will be confirmed to Mrs Dunglison in writing.
