Agreed Removal Decision

On 31 August 2023 we received a referral raising a concern about Linda Mary Ford's fitness to practise. The referral gave rise to a concern that Linda Mary Ford has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Linda Mary Ford has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 22 December 2025 we received an application from Linda Mary Ford for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Linda Mary Ford's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments from the maker of the allegations dated 23 December 2025
- agreed removal application form dated 10 December 2025
- draft charges
- case examiner decision letter dated 15 April 2025
- information obtained as part of investigation to date
- the interests of Linda Mary Ford
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Linda Mary Ford no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Linda Mary Ford aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Linda Mary Ford to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 30 December 2025. In the event that Linda Mary Ford seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
