## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Maria Catherine O'Callaghan

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse – Adult

**Relevant Location:** Wirral Community Health and Care NHS Trust

On 13 September 2024 we received a referral raising a concern regarding Ms O'Callaghan's fitness to practise. It is alleged that Ms O'Callaghan has a health condition which is capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

The NMC investigation has been completed, and the matter has been referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee for adjudication. Ms O'Callaghan is currently subject to an Interim Conditions of Practice Order.

On 20 October 2025 we received an application from Ms O'Callaghan for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Maria Catherine O'Callaghan application for agreed removal, I have taken into account:

- the agreed removal application form, dated 10 June 2025
- evidence obtained in the case so far
- the interests of Ms O'Callaghan
- the public interest.

We have received the views of the person who made the allegation against Ms O'Callaghan, regarding her application for agreed removal. They have confirmed that they do not object.

I am satisfied that:

- Ms O'Callaghan no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- there is enough information to make a decision about the seriousness of the concerns and the public interest in agreeing removal.
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Ms O'Callaghan to leave the NMC register.

We will publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **10<sup>th</sup> December 2025**. In the event that Ms O'Callaghan seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
