Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a reviewing panel will review the interim suspension order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. A reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the interim suspension order at this meeting and Ms Onwuasoanya will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Ms Onwuasoanya is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Ms Onwuasoanya will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the interim order continues to be necessary. Ms Onwuasoanya must inform his case officer if she would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Ms Onwuasoanya does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the interim order should be revoked or replaced, a reviewing panel will review the interim suspension order at a hearing which Ms Onwuasoanya and her representative will be invited to attend.

Ms Onwuasoanya should notify the NMC immediately of any material change of circumstances that may affect the interim order.

At any time, Ms Onwuasoanya or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed by a panel if any relevant new information becomes available.

This will be confirmed to Ms Onwuasoanya in writing.

That concludes this determination.
