## Agreed Removal Decision

**Registrant:** Chloe Schaffield

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Adult Nursing

**Relevant Location:** East Ayrshire

On 31 December 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Chloe Schaffield's fitness to practise. It's alleged that she failed to demonstrate the standards of knowledge, skill and judgement required to practise without supervision as a Band 5 nurse in the following areas:

- medication practice
- wound management
- patient assessment
- record keeping.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Chloe Schaffield has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees. Chloe Schaffield accepts most of the concerns raised about her clinical practice.

On 26 November 2025 we received an application from Chloe Schaffield for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Chloe Schaffield's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Chloe Schaffield
- agreed removal application dated 22 November 2025 and supporting documentation
- report to the case examiners and accompanying documentation
- case examiner decision letter dated 11 September 2025
- case examiner decision letter dated 13 October 2025
- the interests of Chloe Schaffield
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Chloe Schaffield no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Chloe Schaffield aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Chloe Schaffield to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 30 December 2025. In the event that Chloe Schaffield seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
