## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Eleanor Neill

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Mental Health Nursing

**Relevant Location:** County Antrim

On 17 March 2022, we received a referral raising a concern about Eleanor Neill's fitness to practise. The referral raised concerns about patient care, record keeping, communication and working co-operatively with others in a care home setting. It's also alleged that on 3 March 2022, Eleanor Neill used threatening, abusive, aggressive and/or insulting language towards and about colleagues.

Eleanor Neill accepts some of the concerns to do with record keeping and asking someone who wasn't a member of staff to help move a resident. She describes feeling hurt and humiliated by the way she was treated by the care home.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Eleanor Neill has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 12 June 2025, we received an application from Eleanor Neill for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Eleanor Neill's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- the response received from the person who made the allegation against Eleanor Neill
- the reasons for the decision to refer the matter to the Fitness to Practise Committee
- the NMC investigation report and supporting evidence
- the interests of Eleanor Neill
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Eleanor Neill no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- in all the circumstances, the allegations against Eleanor Neill aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Eleanor Neill to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 26 June 2025. In the event that Eleanor Neill seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
