Agreed Removal Decision

Registrant: Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay

On 30 May 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay's fitness to practise. The referral relates to concerns that Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay received a police caution for 6 counts of theft of zopiclone from her place of employment.

Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay admits the concerns and that her fitness to practise is impaired. She has demonstrated insight and remorse for her actions.

The matter was referred to our case examiners. The NMC investigation hasn't finished and the case examiners are yet to decide whether there's a case to answer. No allegation against Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 9 December 2024 we received an application from Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay dated 30 December 2024
- agreed removal application dated 24 November 2024
- Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay's reflective statement
- information obtained as part of investigation to date
- the interests of Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay no longer intends to work as a registered nurse

- although serious, the allegations against Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- that there isn't evidence of a deep seated attitudinal problem
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 22 May 2025. In the event that Roisin Loretta Mary Mckay seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
