Agreed Removal Decision

On 8th April 2025 we received a referral raising a concern about Eunice Ingle's fitness to practise. It's alleged that you failed to demonstrate the standards of knowledge, skill and judgement required to practise without supervision as a band 6 midwife in the following areas

- a. Patient care
- b. medication administration
- c. record keeping
- d. recognition and escalation of clinical risks
- e. effective communication

We investigated the issue, and the matter was referred to the Case Examiners. No allegation against Eunice Ingle has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 19th June 2025 we received an application from Eunice Ingle for agreed removal from the NMC Register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC Register in this case because:

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Eunice Ingle's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Eunice Ingle
- the Investigations & the Agreed Removal bundles
- the interests of Eunice Ingle
- the public interest

The maker of the allegation did not have any comments on the application for removal from the register.

I'm satisfied that:

- Eunice Ingle no longer intends to work as a registered midwife
- the allegations against Eunice Ingle are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration,
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time,
- the public interest is best served by the immediate removal of Eunice Ingle's name from the NMC Register.

This record of decision will be published for twelve months from the date of the decision. In the event that Eunice Ingle seeks readmission to the Register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
