Agreed Removal Decision

On 12 December 2022 we received a self-referral raising a concern about Lauren Blyth's fitness to practise. The referral gave rise to a concern that Lauren Blyth has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to our Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Lauren Blyth has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 4 August 2025 we received an application from Lauren Blyth for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Lauren Blyth's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- Agreed removal application and documents obtained during the investigation of this case
- medical documents about Lauren Blyth's health condition/s and information about the impact upon her practice
- the interests of Lauren Blyth
- the public interest.

We didn't seek comments from any other party about the application for agreed removal as this case arose from a self-referral and relates to Lauren Blyth's health.

I'm satisfied that:

- Lauren Blyth no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Lauren Blyth aren't likely to result in a striking-off order

- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Lauren Blyth to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 9 September 2025. In the event that Lauren Blyth seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
