Agreed Removal Decision

On 13 February 2023, we received a referral raising a concern about Rohena Mary Latif's fitness to practise. It's alleged that between February and December 2022, Rohena Mary Latif failed to demonstrate the standards of knowledge, skill and judgment required to practise without supervision as a Band 5 nurse.

Rohena Mary Latif doesn't accept the concern, providing reasons and setting out several factors that she says played a part in why the issues arose.

We carried out an investigation and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Rohena Mary Latif has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 14 May 2025, we received an application from Rohena Mary Latif for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Rohena Mary Latif's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person who made the allegation against Rohena Mary Latif
- the agreed removal application form and supporting documents
- the reasons for the decision to refer the matter to the Fitness to Practise Committee
- the interests of Rohena Mary Latif
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Rohena Mary Latif no longer intends to work as a registered nurse

- the allegations against Rohena Mary Latif aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Rohena Mary Latif to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **4 September 2025**. In the event that Rohena Mary Latif seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
