## Nursing and Midwifery Council Agreed Removal Decision

On 24 March 2025 we received a referral raising a concern about Mrs Selen Mathew's fitness to practise.

It's alleged that Mrs Selan Mathew lacked competence in that she failed to demonstrate the standards of knowledge, skill and judgment required to practice without supervision as a Band 5 nurse in the following areas:

- (a) Patient management
- (b) Recognition and escalation of deteriorating patients
- (c) Record keeping
- (d) Clinical skills
- (e) Communication
- (f) Medication administration

We investigated the issue, and the matter was referred to the Case Examiners. No allegation against Mrs Selen Mathew has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 1 May 2025 we received an application from Mrs Selen Mathew for agreed removal from the NMC Register.

## ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC Register in this case because:

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Mrs Selen Mathew's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- that maker of the allegation against Mrs Selen Mathew does not object to the agreed removal application
- the live investigation bundle and all the correspondence
- the interests of Mrs Selen Mathew
- the public interest

## I'm satisfied that:

- Mrs Selen Mathew no longer intends to work as a registered nurse and has left the country
- the allegations against Mrs Selen Mathew are not so serious as to result in a striking off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time,
- the public interest is best served by the immediate removal of Mrs Selen Mathew's name from the NMC Register.

This record of decision will be published for twelve months from the date of the decision: 5<sup>th</sup> September 2025. In the event that Mrs Selen Mathew seeks readmission to the Register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
