## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Rebecca Barton

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Adult Nursing

**Relevant Location:** East Cheshire

On 21 April 2020 we received a referral raising a concern about Rebecca Barton's fitness to practise. It's alleged that Rebecca Barton in April 2019, administered piriton to Patient B, without a prescription, failed to give prescribed medication Phenobarbital to Patient C on three occasions in January 2020 and in April 2020, failed to give Patient A the correct dose of subcutaneous Midazolam.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to Case Examiners. No allegation against Rebecca Barton has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 8 December 2025 we received an application from Rebecca Barton for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Rebecca Barton's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Rebecca Barton
- Agreed removal application form and case examiner bundle
- the interests of Rebecca Barton
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Rebecca Barton no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Rebecca Barton aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Rebecca Barton to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from **14 March 2026** of the decision. In the event that Rebecca Barton seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
