Agreed Removal Decision

On 13 June 2023 we received a referral raising a concern about Claire Bosanquet's fitness to practise. It's alleged that Claire Bosanquet lacked competence in medication management, record keeping, infection control, time management, patient assessment, patient care and wound care. Claire Bosanquet accepts she lacked competence in relation to record keeping and medication management, with the remainder of the allegations, and some of the specific incidents, being disputed.

The referral also gave rise to a concern that Claire Bosanquet has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

We investigated the issues and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Claire Bosanquet has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 8 April 2026 we received an application from Claire Bosanquet for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Claire Bosanquet's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- Claire Bosanquet's application for agreed removal
- the evidence we've gathered during our investigation
- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Claire Bosanquet
- the interests of Claire Bosanquet
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Claire Bosanquet no longer intends to work as a registered nurse

- the allegations against Claire Bosanquet aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Claire Bosanquet to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 23 April 2026. In the event that Claire Bosanquet seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
