## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Helen Joyce Champion

**PIN:** 85F0915E

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Adult Nursing

**Relevant Location:** Lancashire

On 22 September 2023 we received a referral raising a concern about Helen Joyce Champion's fitness to practise. The concerns raised are that Helen Joyce Champion:

- failed to respond appropriately to medical incidents
- failed to accurately document incidents
- failed to maintain a resident's dignity when carrying out an assessment.

Helen Joyce Champion does not admit the concerns that have been raised.

The matter was referred to the case examiners but we haven't yet finished our investigation. No allegation against Helen Joyce Champion has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 6 November 2025 we received an application from Helen Joyce Champion for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Helen Joyce Champion's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- agreed removal application form dated 1 November 2025
- documents obtained from the investigation of the case
- the interests of Helen Joyce Champion
- the public interest.

We sought to contact the person who made the allegation against Helen Joyce Champion for their comments on the application for agreed removal. No comments were received within a reasonable period.

I'm satisfied that:

- there's enough information for me to make a decision about the seriousness of the concerns and the public interest in removing Helen Joyce Champion from our register without completing our investigation
- Helen Joyce Champion no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Helen Joyce Champion aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Helen Joyce Champion to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 10 April 2026. In the event that Helen Joyce Champion seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
