Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to replace the interim conditions of practice order with an interim suspension order.

The interim suspension order will be reviewed every six months. This order runs for the remainder of the 18 month period.

At any time, Ms Robu or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed by a panel if any relevant new information becomes available.

At any review, a panel may revoke it, it may confirm the interim suspension order, or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order. In certain circumstances, it may be possible for the interim order to be reviewed by a panel at an administrative meeting. Ms Robu's case officer will write to her about this in due course.

Ms Robu should notify the NMC immediately of any material change of circumstances that may affect the interim order.

The NMC Case Examiners are yet to decide whether there is a case to answer in relation to the allegations made against Ms Robu. The NMC will write to Ms Robu when the case is ready for the next stage of the fitness to practise process.

That concludes this determination.

This decision will be confirmed to Ms Robu in writing.
