## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Mental Health Nursing

**Relevant Location:** Cornwall

On 26 March 2025 we received a referral raising a concern about Kate Yvonne Dixon's fitness to practise. The referral gave rise to a concern that Kate Yvonne Dixon has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

The referral is at the early stages of the investigation and is yet to be considered by the case examiners. No allegation against Kate Yvonne Dixon has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 4 December 2025 we received an application from Kate Yvonne Dixon for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Kate Yvonne Dixon's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person who made the allegation against Kate Yvonne Dixon dated 4 January 2025
- agreed removal application form dated 4 December 2025 and supporting documentation
- statement from Kate Yvonne Dixon dated 4 December 2025
- documentation obtained as part of investigation to date
- the interests of Kate Yvonne Dixon
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Kate Yvonne Dixon no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Kate Yvonne Dixon aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Kate Yvonne Dixon to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **12 February 2026**. In the event that Kate Yvonne Dixon seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
