Agreed Removal Decision

On 12 September 2022 we received a referral raising a concern about Mr Ramdin's fitness to practise. It's alleged that Mr Ramdin inappropriately accessed patient records and accepted a conditional caution for malicious communication.

We have not yet completed our investigation of the issue. The matter has been referred to our Investigations team. No fitness to practise allegation against Mr Ramdin has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 8 July 2025 we received an application from Mr Ramdin for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Mr Ramdin's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- Mr Ramdin's application for agreed removal, his response to the allegations and accompanying documents.
- the interests of Mr Ramdin.
- the public interest.

We sought to contact the person who was involved in the allegations against Mr Ramdin for their comments on the application for agreed removal. No comments were received within a reasonable period.

I'm satisfied that:

- Mr Ramdin no longer intends to work as a registered nurse.
- The allegations against Mr Ramdin aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- There are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

- The public interest and public confidence in the profession is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Mr Ramdin to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **9 February 2026**. In the event that Mr Ramdin seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
