## Agreed Removal Decision

**Registrant:** Bethan Warburton

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Mental Health

**Relevant Location:** Southeast Wales

On 3 July 2023 we received a referral raising a concern Bethan Warburton's fitness to practise. It is alleged that on 3 June 2023 Bethan Warburton participated in inappropriate moving and handling of a patient on her shift.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the investigation team. No allegation against Bethan Warburton has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 17 September 2025 we received an application Bethan Warburton requesting for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Bethan Warburton's application for agreed removal, I have considered:

1. Agreed removal bundle containing:
  - Agreed removal application form.
  - Response from the maker of the allegation
  - Supporting documents from RCN
2. Live Investigation Bundle
3. the interests of Bethan Warburton
4. the public interest.

The NMC wrote to the maker of the allegation on 24 September 2025. They have responded to inform us that they do not object to the Bethan Warburton's immediate removal from the register.

I am satisfied that:

- Bethan Warburton no longer intends to work as a registered nurse.
- the allegations against Bethan Warburton are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration.

- there are currently no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further.
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Bethan Warburton to leave the NMC register.

We will publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **24 February 2026**. If Bethan Warburton seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
