Agreed Removal Decision

On 16 October 2025 we received a referral raising a concern about Kamil Wysocki's fitness to practise. It's alleged that Kamil Wysocki administered medication without being qualified or competent to do so.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to Screening. No allegation against Kamil Wysocki has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 22 October 2025 we received an application from Kamil Wysocki for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Kamil Wysocki's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Kamil Wysocki
- agreed removal application form dated 22 October 2025
- the outcome of the interim order hearing held on 12 November 2025
- response from the maker of the allegation dated 4 November 2025
- case investigation material gathered so far
- the evidence provided by Kamil Wysocki regarding his future intentions
- the interests of Kamil Wysocki
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Kamil Wysocki no longer intends to work as a registered nursing associate

- the allegations against Kamil Wysocki aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Kamil Wysocki to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision. In the event that Kamil Wysocki seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
