## Agreed Removal Decision

**Registrant:** Jessica Louise Masters

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Midwife

**Relevant Location:** Surrey

On 10 August 2023, we received a referral raising a concern about Jessica Louise Masters' fitness to practise. It's alleged that between 31 October 2022 and 31 July 2023, Jessica Louise Masters failed to demonstrate the standards of knowledge, skill, and judgment required to practise without supervision as a band 5 midwife.

Jessica Masters accepts the concerns and said that she accepts that she's not fit to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Jessica Louise Masters has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 22 December 2025, we received an application from Jessica Louise Masters for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Jessica Louise Masters' application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- the agreed removal application form and supporting documents
- the reasons for the decision to refer the matter to the Fitness to Practise Committee
- the interests of Jessica Louise Masters
- the public interest.

We sought to contact the person who made the allegation against Jessica Louise Masters for their comments on the application for agreed removal. No comments were received within a reasonable period.

I'm satisfied that:

- Jessica Louise Masters no longer intends to work as a registered midwife

- the allegations against Jessica Louise Masters aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Jessica Louise Masters to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **16 January 2026**. In the event that Jessica Louise Masters seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
