Agreed Removal Decision

On 16 May 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Elizabeth Jayne Morgan's fitness to practise. The referral gave rise to a concern that Elizabeth Jayne Morgan has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

We investigated the matter and a set of undertakings were agreed as a pathway back to safe practice. No allegation against Elizabeth Jayne Morgan has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 5 December 2025, we received an application from Elizabeth Jayne Morgan for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Elizabeth Jayne Morgan's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person who made the allegation against Elizabeth Jayne Morgan
- the application for agreed removal and supporting documents
- the reasons for the decision to offer undertakings
- the interests of Elizabeth Jayne Morgan
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Elizabeth Jayne Morgan no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Elizabeth Jayne Morgan aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Elizabeth Jayne Morgan to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **9 January 2026**. In the event that Elizabeth Jayne Morgan seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
