## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Michelle Evonne Ord

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Adult Nursing

**Relevant Location:** Merseyside

On 30 June 2023 we received a self-referral, making us aware of concerns about Michelle Evonne Ord's fitness to practise. We subsequently received a referral from an employer on 29 December 2023, raising further concerns. Both referrals gave rise to a concern that Michelle Evonne Ord has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to our Fitness to Practise Committee. No allegation against Michelle Evonne Ord has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 23 July 2025 we received an application from Michelle Evonne Ord for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Michelle Evonne Ord's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the employer that raised the concerns about Michelle Evonne Ord
- documents and information about the alleged concerns
- Michelle Evonne Ord's responses to the alleged concerns
- our case examiners' decision
- the interests of Michelle Evonne Ord
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Michelle Evonne Ord no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the concerns about Michelle Evonne Ord aren't likely to result in a striking-off order

- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the concerns further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Michelle Evonne Ord to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **22 January 2026**. In the event that Michelle Evonne Ord seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
