Agreed Removal Decision

On 9 January 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Lisa Jane Owen's fitness to practise. It's alleged that she alerted colleagues to a possible safeguarding concern about a patient which turned out to be incorrect.

The referral also gave rise to a concern that Lisa Jane Owen has a health condition capable of impairing her fitness to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the case examiners. No allegation against Lisa Jane Owen has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 12 December 2025 we received an application from Lisa Jane Owen for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Lisa Jane Owen's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- the agreed removal application form dated 12 December 2025 and supporting documents
- documents obtained during the investigation of the case
- the case examiners' reasons
- the interests of Lisa Jane Owen
- the public interest
- comments received from the person that made the allegation against Lisa Jane Owen.

I'm satisfied that:

- Lisa Jane Owen no longer intends to work as a registered nurse

- the allegations against Lisa Jane Owen aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Lisa Jane Owen to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 27 January 2026. In the event that Lisa Jane Owen seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
