## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Fiona Wilda Richardson

**NMC PIN:** 16I1059S

**Part(s) of the register:** Nursing

**Relevant Location:** Scotland

On 7 June 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Fiona Wilda Richardson's fitness to practise. It's alleged she failed to respond appropriately to a resident's fall on 24 January 2024 and failed to conduct and record observations.

We investigated the matter and referred it to the Case Examiners for consideration under our procedures. No findings have been made by any of our statutory committees in relation to Fiona Wilda Richardson.

On 11 August 2025 we received an application from Ms Richardson for agreed removal from the NMC Register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC Register in this case because:

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Fiona Wilda Richardson's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- Fiona Wilda Richardson agreed removal application and supporting documents
- the documentation obtained during the investigation
- the interests of Fiona Wilda Richardson
- the public interest

The person that made the allegation against Fiona Wilda Richardson agrees to the application for removal from their Register but does not want to make any comments.

I'm satisfied that:

- Fiona Wilda Richardson no longer intends to work as a registered

- the allegations against Fiona Wilda Richardson aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time,
- the public interest is best served by the immediate removal of Fiona Wilda Richardson's name from the NMC Register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, 7 January 2026. In the event that Fiona Wilda Richardson seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
