Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

Accordingly, the panel was satisfied that the order remains necessary on the same grounds and for the same reasons as previously stated by the Investigating Committee panel at the last review on 5 February 2026.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim conditions of practice order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Mr Clulow will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Mr Clulow is entitled to have the interim conditions of practice order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Mr Clulow will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on his behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Mr Clulow must inform his case officer if he would like the interim conditions of practice order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Mr Clulow does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Mr Clulow and his representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Mr Clulow in writing.
