Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to replace the current interim conditions of practice order with interim suspension order.

Unless Mr Onunkwo's case has already been concluded, this interim order must be reviewed before the end of the next six months and every six months thereafter. Additionally, Mr Onunkwo or the NMC may ask for the interim order to be reviewed if any new evidence becomes available that may be relevant to the interim order.

Where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, or there has been a request for an early review, a panel will review the interim order at a hearing which Mr Onunkwo will be invited to attend in person, send a representative on Mr Onunkwo's behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider.

At any such review hearing the panel may revoke the interim order, it may confirm the interim suspension order or it may replace it with an interim conditions of practice order.

This decision will be confirmed to Mr Onunkwo in writing.
