Conditions attached to the Registrant's registration are as follows:

1. You must keep the NMC informed about anywhere you are working by:
 - a. Telling your case officer within seven days of accepting or leaving any employment;
 - b. Giving your case officer your employer's contact details.
2. You must immediately give a copy of these conditions to:
 - a. Any organisation or person you work for;
 - b. Any agency you apply to or are registered with for work;
 - c. Any employers you apply to for work (at the time of application);
 - d. Any establishment you apply to (at the time of application), or with which you are already enrolled, for a course of study;
 - e. Any current or prospective patients or clients you intend to see or care for when you are working independently
3. You must tell your case officer, within seven days of your becoming aware of:
 - a. Any clinical incident you are involved in;
 - b. Any investigation started against you;
 - c. Any disciplinary proceedings taken against you.
4. You must ensure that you are supervised by a senior nurse (Band 6 or above) in that you must ensure that you work at all times on the same shift as, but not always directly observed by, a registered nurse of Band 6 or above.
5. You must ensure that you only handle medications whilst under the direct supervision of a Medical Officer (Doctor or above).
