Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

Unless Ms Woodward's case has already been concluded or there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the conditions of practice order at a review meeting within the next six months and every six months thereafter. A panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the conditions of practice order at this meeting and Ms Woodward will be notified of the panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, or there has been a request for an early review, a panel will review the interim order at a hearing which Ms Woodward will be invited to attend in person, send a representative on Ms Woodward behalf or submit written representations for the panel to consider. At any such review hearing the panel may revoke the interim order, it may confirm the conditions of practice order or it may replace it with an interim suspension order.

A panel of the Fitness to Practise Committee has still to deal with the allegations made against Ms Woodward. The NMC will keep Ms Woodward informed of developments in relation to that issue.

This will be confirmed to Ms Woodward in writing.
