Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) to confirm the order at this meeting and Mrs Ajen will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Mrs Ajen is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Mrs Ajen will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Mrs Ajen must inform her case officer if she would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Mrs Ajen does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Mrs Ajen and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Mrs Ajen in writing.

That concludes this determination.
