Agreed Removal Decision

On 4 August 2021 we received a referral raising a concern about Christopher Ronald Currie's fitness to practise. It is alleged that Christopher Ronald Currie's lacked the competence to practice as a nurse and failed to demonstrate the standards of knowledge, skill and judgement required to practise without supervision as a Band 5 nurse.

The referral from the Trust gave rise to a concern that Christopher Ronald Currie has a health condition capable of impairing his fitness to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Case Examiners. Undertakings have been in place since February 2024. No allegation against Christopher Ronald Currie has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 16 January 2026 we received an application from Christopher Ronald Currie for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Christopher Ronald Currie's application for agreed removal, I have considered:

- Agreed removal application form dated 16 January 2026
- Agreed Removal admissions form 10 February 2026
- Case Examiners decision and recommendation for undertakings
- Documentation from the employer and Christopher Ronald Currie
- the interests of Christopher Ronald Currie
- the public interest.

We sought to contact the person who made the allegation against Christopher Ronald Currie for their comments on the application for agreed removal. No comments were received within a reasonable period.

I am satisfied that:

- Christopher Ronald Currie no longer intends to work as a registered nurse
- the allegations against Christopher Ronald Currie are not so serious as to be fundamentally incompatible with continued registration
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Christopher Ronald Currie to leave the NMC register.

We will publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **4 June 2026**. If Christopher Ronald Currie seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
