## Agreed Removal Decision

**Registrant:** Michele Mozart Smith

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Nurse - Adult

**Relevant Location:** Tayside

On 9 September 2025 we received a referral raising a concern about Michele Mozart Smith's fitness to practise. It is alleged that Mrs Smith shouted at a resident who had entered a communal area undressed, causing them to experience distress. In their statements, staff members at the home reported that Mrs Smith would regularly shout at residents and that she had also denied a resident access to the lounge and dining room.

No allegation against Mrs Smith has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 23 October 2025 we received an application from Mrs Smith for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Mrs Smith's application for agreed removal, I have considered:

- Agreed removal application form, dated 23 October 2025
- Investigation documentation gathered so far
- The interests of Mrs Smith
- The public interest.

We wrote to the maker of the allegation on 29 October 2025 and 14 November 2025. They responded on 4 December 2025 stating that they did not wish to comment on Mrs Smith's application for agreed removal.

I am satisfied that:

- Mrs Smith no longer intends to work as a registered nurse.
- The allegations against Mrs Smith are not so serious as to lead to striking off.

- There are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further currently.
- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Mrs Smith to leave the NMC register.

We will publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **20 March 2026**. If Mrs Smith seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
