## **Decision and reasons on interim order**

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Accordingly, the panel was satisfied that the order remains necessary on the same grounds and for the same reasons as previously stated by the Investigating Committee panel at the last review on 15 December 2025.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Mr Adrienne will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Mr Adrienne is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Mr Adrienne will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on his behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Mr Adrienne must inform his case officer if he would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Mr Adrienne does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Mr Adrienne and his representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Mr Adrienne in writing.
