Outcome of review: **Interim suspension order confirmed**

Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim suspension order.

Unless Ms Hammerton's case has already been concluded or there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim suspension order at a review meeting within the next six months and every six months thereafter. A panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the interim suspension order at this meeting and Ms Hammerton will be notified of the panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Mrs Hammerton is entitled to have the interim suspension order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Mrs Hammerton will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Mrs Hammerton must inform her case officer if she would like the interim suspension order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Mrs Hammerton does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Mrs Hammerton and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Mrs Hammerton in writing.
