## **Agreed Removal Decision**

**Registrant:** Sarah Jane Green

**PIN:** 11C0031E

**Part(s) of the register:** Registered Midwife

**Relevant Location:** Norfolk

On 12 February 2026 we received a referral raising a concern about Sarah Jane Green's fitness to practise. It's alleged she lacked competence in medication administration, monitoring and assessing patients, communication and handing over to colleagues. It's also alleged that she communicated with staff in an inappropriate and unprofessional way. Sarah Jane Green accepts some but not all of the concerns.

We referred the matter to the case examiners and we're in the process of investigating the concerns. No allegation against Sarah Jane Green has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 2 March 2026 we received an application from Sarah Jane Green for agreed removal from the NMC register.

### **ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION**

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Sarah Jane Green's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account:

- comments received from the person who made the allegation against Sarah Jane Green
- documents that we've obtained so far in our investigation
- the interests of Sarah Jane Green
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Sarah Jane Green no longer intends to work as a registered midwife
- the allegations against Sarah Jane Green aren't likely to result in a striking-off order
- there are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time

- the public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Sarah Jane Green to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **18 September 2026**. In the event that Sarah Jane Green seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
