Agreed Removal Decision

On 19 February 2024 we received a referral raising a concern about Mr Larkin's fitness to practise. The referral gave rise to a concern that Mr Larkin has a health condition capable of impairing his fitness to practise.

We investigated the issue and the matter was referred to the Case Examiners for a decision. No allegation against Mr Larkin has yet been found substantively proved by one of our statutory committees.

On 1 April 2026 we received an application from Mr Larkin for agreed removal from the NMC register.

ASSISTANT REGISTRAR'S DECISION

As an Assistant Registrar, I have delegated authority to make decisions about agreed removal and have agreed to removal from the NMC register in this case.

In accordance with Rule 14 of the Nursing and Midwifery Council (Education, Registration and Registration Appeals) Rules 2004, in considering Mr Larkin's application for agreed removal, I've taken into account;

- documents from Mr Larkin's employer
- the interests of Mr Larkin
- the public interest.

I'm satisfied that:

- Mr Larkin no longer intends to work as a registered nurse.
- The allegations against Mr Larkin are not likely to result in a striking-off order.
- There are no other good reasons requiring us to consider the allegations further at this time.
- The public interest is best served by agreeing the application for removal and enabling Mr Larkin to leave the NMC register.

We'll publish a record of this decision for twelve months from the date of the decision, **4 September 2026**. In the event that Mr Larkin seeks readmission to the register, we may consider the matters that led to this agreed removal further.
