Decision and reasons on interim order

The panel decided to confirm the current interim conditions of practice order.

Unless there has been a material change of circumstances, a panel will review the interim conditions of practice order at an administrative meeting within the next six months. The reviewing panel will be invited by the NMC to confirm the order at this meeting and Ms Mcalonan will be notified of that panel's decision in writing following that meeting.

Alternatively, Ms Mcalonan is entitled to have the interim conditions of practice order reviewed at a hearing. This means that Ms Mcalonan will be able to attend and make representations, send a representative on her behalf or submit written representations about whether the order continues to be necessary. Ms Mcalonan must inform her case officer if she would like the interim conditions of practice order to be reviewed at a hearing.

Even if Ms Mcalonan does not request a hearing, where there has been a material change of circumstances that might mean that the order should be revoked or replaced, a panel will review the order at a hearing to which Ms Mcalonan and her representative will be invited to attend.

This decision will be confirmed to Ms Mcalonan in writing.
