REQUIREMENTS FOR PUPIL NURSE TRAINING

The training period to be 96 weeks, exclusive of Annual Leave and Sick/
 Special Leave.

THEORETICAL PROGRAMME

4 weeks

Introductory Course

This course to commence with a period of instruction of
 4 consecutive weeks in the classroom, or 8 consecutive
 weeks to be spent between the wards and the classroom.
 Total hours of instruction - 120 hours

Study Days or equivalent Study Blocks - 20 Study Days

This programme of theoretical instruction to be completed
 by the end of the first year in training and should
 include Lectures in the following subjects:-

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

Chronic Back / Musculoskeletal Not less than 8 weeks

Other clinical nursing experience

(a) to be allocated at the discretion of the College training staff. 72 weeks

(b) in order to ensure the pupil nurse's experience, the clinical should be given in an approved hospital. This experience must be given with a planned programme of instruction. Not less than 8 weeks

If clinical experience is given mainly in the care of patients with a physical disorder, further experience should be given in the care of the patient with a mental disorder or mental handicap.

If clinical nursing experience is given mainly in the care of patients with a mental disorder of a mental handicap further experience should be given in the care of patients with a physical disorder.
